EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, BPPD-II, E&AM SECTOR for and on behalf of Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority (KMDA) invites **ON LINE e-TENDER** in KMDA Form No: 1 from reliable, resourceful, bonafide, eligible firms/companies/individual/Joint Venture agencies who have successfully & satisfactorily completed the **similar nature of works in a single contract not less than 30% of the value of work put to tender or minimum 25% of the value of work put to tender in each of two separate contracts** within last **5(five) years from the date of NIT** in any Government/Semi Government /Undertaking/Autonomous bodies/Local bodies.

 - RTGS/NEFT in case of offline payment through bank account in any bank.
 - Submission of Tender:- a) Pre-qualification/Technical Bid and Financial Bid both will have to be submitted online concurrently duly digitally signed in the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in> as per time schedule stated herein under. Time will be reckoned as per Server Clock. b) The Financial Bid of the Participant tenderers will be opened only if the tenderer qualifies in the Technical Bid evaluation.

Tenders will be opened by the **EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, BPPD-II, E&AM SECTOR, KMDA** or his authorized representative in presence of tenderer or their authorized representatives who may like to be present.

5. Eligibility criteria for the bidders:-

- The bidders should have the credentials of similar nature of works completed successfully & satisfactorily with the value not less than 30% of the estimated amount put to tender in a single contract or not less than 25% of the estimated amount put to tender in each of two separate tenders. Nature of works should be clearly mentioned.
- Scanned copy of valid up to date Professional Tax receipt Challan, GST as per latest Govt. order and PAN card issued by Income Tax Department, Valid Income tax(For last 3yrs), Last 3yrs. Audited balance sheet, EPF & ESI Registration certificate, Credentials, Work Order, Payment certificate and other supporting documents, Registration Certificate and/or trade license of the company must be submitted duly digitally signed at desired location in the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in>.

5.1 Declaration on Notary

Scanned Copy of one affidavit before Notary will have to be submitted **mentioning the NIT No.** and the correctness of the documents and a declaration of penalty debarment etc. faced by him under any Govt./Semi-Govt./Autonomous body/Institution through on line at desired location.

5.2 Partnership Firm/Consortium should submit necessary deed at desired location through on line.

5.3 Particulars regarding Joint Ventures/Consortium.

- The lead partner shall meet not less than 50% of the qualifying criteria mentioned above under any Govt./Semi-Govt. organization/Autonomous body as principal employer within last 5 (Five) years.
- Whereas each of the other partners shall meet individually not less than 25% of the qualifying criteria mentioned above under any Govt./Semi-Govt. organization/Autonomous body as principal employer within last 5 (Five) years.
- The lead partner shall have to apply for tender on behalf of Joint Ventures/Consortium along with MoA/MoU.
- In case of any litigation or in the event of any default arises during the execution/contract period of the agreement, the lead partner will remain fully responsible.
- The successful Joint Ventures/Consortium will have to submit GST Registration. Pan Card, Trade License immediately after issuance of LOI.

Provision of Defect Liability Period & Refund of Security Deposit :Prospective bidders shall have to execute the work in such a manner so that appropriate service level for the stipulated work is to be maintained during stipulated contractual period till actual date of completion and a Defect Liability Period for the work is **05(Five) years from the date of actual successful completion of the work.** If any defect/damage is found during the period as mentioned above, the contractor shall make good the same at his own expense to the specification at par within stant project work, or in default, the Engineer-in-charge may cause the same to be made good by other agency and deduct the expense (for which the certificate of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final) from any sums that may be then, or at any time here after become due to contractor, or from his security deposit, or the proceeds of the sale thereof, or of sufficient portion thereof or from any pending dues for any contract with KMDA. For five years defect liability period, 30% of the Total Security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of four years from the actual date of completion of the work and the balance 70% of the Security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of five years from the actual date of completion of the work.

- a) **Earnest Money:-** The tenderer shall have to mention the reference detail in support of remitted RTGS/NEFT of requisite EMD against the tender in prescribed location failing which the tender shall be rejected. The balance earnest money if any to fulfill 2(two) percent of the tender value is to be deposited at the time of execution of formal agreement.
- b) **Additional Performance Security:-** On receiving of the bid, If it is found, the Tendered amount is 80% or Below of the Estimated amount, the L1 Bidder should have to deposit Additional Performance Security @ 10% of the Tendered amount in the form of Bank Guaranty in favour of KMDA for the entire contract period within 7(Seven) days from the date of issuance of LOI. The B.G will be returned immediately on successful completion of the maintenance period i.e. one year from the date of completion of the work.

8.0 **Financial:**

- i. The bidder should have minimum average annual turnover of **Rs. 15.00 (twenty four) lakh only during three consecutive financial year within last 5 (five) years ending on 31.03.2024.. (Relevant documents shall be uploaded by the bidder through Tender Portal (www.wbtenders.gov.in) for checking the eligibility).**

A. **List of common documents shall have to be uploaded by each tenderer at the time of submission of Tender through online:-**

- i. Income Tax e-Return (For last 3yrs, 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25)
- ii. Audited Balance Sheet (As above, 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24)
- iii. Pan Card.
- iv. Professional Tax Enrolment certificate with current year challan along with Professional Tax Payment Certificate.
- v. Valid 15 digit Goods and Services Taxpayer Identification Number (GSTIN) under GST Act. 2017 & Latest GST Return in Form No. 3B.
- vi. EPF & ESI Registration Certificate along with current monthly contribution receipts for the month of December, 2024
- vii. Valid Renewed Trade License.
- viii. Affidavit before Notary **mentioning the NIT No.** and the correctness of the documents and a declaration of penalty debarment etc.
- ix. Reference details of EMD Remittance
- x. Work Order with completion certificate for the work in technical credential.
- xi. Bank Solvency not more than one year old from the date of NIT.

B. **List of documents shall have to upload by a Partnership Firm in addition to Sl. No. 7.A**

- i. The power of Attorney for the firm for signing the tender by a partner.
- ii. Partnership Deed

C. **List of documents shall have to upload by a Joint Venture/Consortium in addition to Sl. No. 7.A**

- i) Copy of MoA/MoU on a stamp paper of Rs.100.00 outlining the joint interest to work on the project and specifying the other terms of agreement.

9.0 **Grounds for suspension and debarment :**

- i) Submission of eligibility requirements containing false information or falsified documents.
- ii) Submission of Bids that contain false information or falsified documents, or the concealment of such information in the Bids in order to influence the outcome of eligibility screening or any other stage of the bidding process.
- iii) Unauthorized use of one's name/digital signature certificate for purpose of bidding process.
- iv) Any documented unsolicited attempt by a bidder to unduly influence the outcome of the bidding in his favour.
- v) Refusal or failure to post a self-declaration to the effect of any previous debarment imposed by any authority of State / Central Govt., State / Central Govt. Undertaking / Statutory Bodies constituted under the statute of the Central/State Govt.
- vi) All other acts that tend to defeat the purpose of the competitive bidding such as lodging false complain

about any bidder, lodging false complain about any officer duly authorized by the department, restraining any interested bidder to participate in the bidding process, etc.

vii) Assignment and subcontracting of the contract or any part thereof without prior written approval of the procuring entity.

viii) Whenever adverse reports related to adverse performance, misbehavior, direct or indirect involvement in threatening, making false complaints etc. damaging the reputation of the department or any other type complaint considered fit by the competent authority of the department, are received from more than one officer or at more than one occasion from individual officer.

ix) Refusal or failure to post the required performance security / earnest money within the prescribed time without justifiable cause.

x) Failure in deployment of technical personnel, engineers and / or work supervisor having requisite license/ supervisor certificate of competency as specified in the Contract.

xi) Refusal to accept an award after issuance of Letter of Intent or enter into contract with the authority without justifiable cause.

xii) Failure of the contractor, due solely to his fault or negligence, to mobilize and start work or performance within the specified period as mentioned in the Letter of Intent, Letter of Intent cum Work Order, Work Order etc.

xiii) Failure by the contractor to fully and faithfully comply with its contractual, obligations without valid cause, or failure by the contractor to comply with any written lawful instruction of the procuring entity or its representative(s) pursuant to the implementation of the contract.

xiv) For the procurement of consultancy service/ contracts, poor performance by the consultant of his services arising from his fault or negligence. Any of the following acts by the consultant shall be construed as poor performance.

- a) Non deployment of competent technical personnel, competent engineers and / or work supervisors;
- b) Non deployment of committed equipment, facilities, support staff and manpower; and
- c) Defective design resulting in substantial corrective works in design and/or construction;
- d) Failure to deliver critical outputs due to consultants fault or negligence; and
- e) Specifying materials which are inappropriate and substandard or way above acceptable standards leading to high procurement cost.
- f) Allowing defective workmanship or works by the contractor being supervised by the consultant.

xv) For the procurement of goods, unsatisfactory progress in the delivery of the goods by the manufacturer, supplier or distributor arising from his fault or negligence and/or unsatisfactory or inferior quality of goods, vis a vis as laid down in the contract.

xvi) Willful or deliberate abandonment or non-performance of the project or contract by the contractor resulting to substantial breach thereof without lawful and/or just cause.

10. Language of Tender:- The tender shall be submitted in the prescribed form in English. All literatures and correspondence in connection with the tenders shall be in English.

11. Others:- The Tender Notice along with other documents like Tender Form No. -1 KMDA, Technical Specification, Special Terms and Conditions , BOQ, Addendum and corrigendum etc. whatever documents uploaded by the department concerned thereto shall be part and parcel of the Tender.

12. Declaration:- Tenderer must upload and submit duly digitally signed a declaration as per prescribed format for confirmation of his awareness of the contract.

13. Addenda/Corrigenda: During the tenure of the tender if any addenda/corrigenda takes place that will be circulated only through the Government e-Procurement system.
