Tenders are to be submitted online and intending bidders are to download the tender documents from the websitesstated above, directly with the help of the e-Token provided. This is the only mode of collection of tenderdocuments. Details of submission procedure are given below under "General terms and conditions and information".

The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of the NIT carefully. He should particularly go through theeligibility criteria required and satisfy himself of the requirements for eligibility. He should only submit his bid if heconsiders himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.

All information posted on the website consisting of NIT and related documents, Form No I, BOQ, Corrigendum etc.and Drawings if any, shall form part of the tender document.

General Terms and Conditions and Information:

1. Eligibility for participation:

Bonafide Contractors, Registered Engineers Co-operative Societies and Partnership firms registered with the State Government are eligible to participate, depending on the criteria as detailed below.

2. Submission of Tenders

2.1 General process of submission

Tenders are to be submitted online through the website stated. All the documents uploaded by the Tender Inviting Authority form an integral part of the contract. Tenderers are required to upload all the tender documents along with the other documents, as asked for in the tender, through the above website within the stipulated date and time as given in the Tender. Tenders are to be submitted in two folders at a time for each work, one is Technical Proposal and the other



isFinancialProposal.Thetenderershallcarefullygothroughthedocumentsandpreparetherequired documents and upload the scanned documents in Portable Document Format (PDF) to the portal in the designated locations of Technical Bid. He needs to fill up the rates of items /percentage in the BOQ, downloaded for the work, in the designated Cell and upload the same indesignated location of Financial Bid. The documents uploaded are virus scanned and digitallysigned using the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). Tenderers should specifically take note of allthe addendum / corrigendum related to the tender and upload the latest documents as part of thetender.

2.2 Technical Proposal

2.2.1 Financial Proposal

Completion Certificate:

- (i) Completion Certificates for fully completed works during the current year and last five financialyears will only be accepted. Certificates issued for partly completed works will not be considered.

3.1 Penalty for suppression/ distortion of facts

If any tender fails to produce the original hard copies of the documents (especially CompletionCertificates and audited balance sheets), or any other documents on demand of the TenderEvaluation Committee within a specified timeframe or if any deviation is the hard copiesfrom the uploaded soft copies of if there is any suppression, the Tender Evaluation CommitteeuponsuggestingsuitablepunitivemeasureswillbringthemattertothenoticeoftheChiefEngine er concerned immediately and the tenderer may be suspended from participating in thetendersone-TenderplatformofWaterSupplySector,KMDAasperapprovaloftheChiefEngineer for a maximum period 3 (three) years. In addition, his Earnest Money Deposit will standforfeited to KMDA. The Chief Engineer concerned will issue the necessary orders under intimation to the other Chief Engineers, e-Tendering Cell and also the Department, copy of such order shouldalso invariably to be communicated to the Nodal Officer, e-Governance of this Department with arequest to upload the same in the Departmental website.

3.2 Taxes & duties to be borne by the Contractor

IncomeTax,GST,Professional-Tax,Royalty,Constructionworkers'WelfareCessandsimilarother Taxes as per GOVT. Rule to be borne by the contractor and the rate should be quotedaccordingly after consideration of all these charges.





3.3 Site inspection before submission of tender

Beforesubmittinganytender, the intending tenderers should make themselves acquainted thoroughly with the local conditions prevailing at site by actual inspection of the site and taking into consideration all factors and difficulties like to be involved in the execution of work in all respectincluding transportation of materials, communication facilities, climate conditions, nature of soil, availability of local labour and market rate prevailing in the locality etc. and no claim, what so ever, will be entertained on these account afterwards. In this connection intending tenderers may contact the office of the Executive Engineer, concerned with the work between 11.30 hours to 16.30 hours on any working day prior to date of submission of tenders.

3.4 Conditional and incomplete tender

Conditional and incomplete tenders are liable to summary rejection.

4. Opening and evaluation of tender

4.1 Opening of Technical Proposal: -

- Technical proposals will be opened by the Tender inviting authority or his authorized representatives electronically from the website stated above, using their Digital Signature Certificate.
- b) Intending tenderers may remain present at the time of opening if they so desire.
- c) Cover (Folder) for Statutory Documents (vide Clause 3.2A) will be opened first and if found in order, Cover (Folder) for Non-statutory Documents (vide Clause 3.2.B) will be opened. If there is anydeficiency in the Statutory Documents, the tender will summarily be rejected.
- d) Decrypted (transformed into readable formats) documents of the Non-statutory Cover will be evaluated to finalize eligible tenderers.

4.2 Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC)

CommitteewillbeconstitutedbytheChiefEngineer,ifrequiredforissuanceoftenderpapers for high value tenders. This will function as Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC), forevaluation of Technical Proposals of thetenders, until further order. Otherwise prevailingsystem will be effective for evaluating tenders.

4.3 Uploading of summary list of technically qualified tenderers (1st round)

- i) Pursuant to scrutiny and decision of the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC), the summary listof eligible tenderers for a particular serial of work who's Financial Proposals will be considered willbe uploaded in the web portals.
- While evaluation, the Committee may summon the tenderers and seek clarification / information oradditional documents or original hard copy of any of the documents already submitted and if thesecannot be produced within the stipulated time frame, their proposals will be liable for rejection.

4.4 Opening and evaluation of Financial Proposal

- Financial proposal soft he tenderers declared technically eligible by the Tender EvaluationCommittee will be opened electronically by the Tender Inviting Authority from the web portalstated above on the prescribed date.
- ii) The encrypted copies will bed encrypted and the rates will be read out to the contractorsremaining present at that time.
- iii) After opening of the financial proposal the preliminary summary result containing inter-alia, nameof contractors and the rates quoted by them will be uploaded.
- iv) If the Tender Accepting Authority is satisfied that the rate obtained is fair and reasonable andthere is no scope of further lowering down of rate, he may after having the comparativestatement checked, upload the final summary result containing the name of contractors and therates quoted by them against each work after acceptance of the rate.
- v) The Tender Accepting Authority may ask any of the tenderers to submit analysis to justify therate quoted by that tenderer.

5. Procedures to be followed when one/two technically tenderers participated in any Tender.

- i) Financial bid of technically qualified single/two Tenderers will not be opened immediately.
- ii) 2ndCallmaybeinvitedimmediatelyaftertechnicalevaluationanduploadingthelistoftheT.Q. bidders of the 1stcall after relaxation of the credential criteria to the extent deemed necessary bythe T.I.A and advertisement to the wholly circulated newspapers.
- If such bidder's technically qualified in the 1stcall intend(s) to change their rates quoted to the1stcall, they need to participate in the 2ndcall and submit fresh fee towards tender cost. Howeverfresh EMD need to be submitted and EMD submitted earlier will be considered. In case of non-submission of fresh fee in the 2ndCall, the ratesquotedinthe1stcallwouldremainvalidwhilethebidsubmittedinthe2ndCall will be rejected.
- iv) If such bidder's technically qualified inthe1stall does not participated in the 2ndCall then the rateof1stall would be deemed torema invaliding the 2ndCall also.
- AfterselectionoftechnicallyqualifiedTenderersfor 2ndCall (incase new tenderer other than the existing tenderer ofthe1stcall), financial bidofboth1stand2ndcallwouldbeopened.

Lowest valid rate should normally be accepted. However, the Tender Accepting Authority does notbind himself to do so and reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders, for valid reasons.

7.1 <u>Timeofcompletion:</u>Timeofcompletionshallbe15days (SL 1)fromthedateofissuanceofthework order.

7.2 Execution of Formal tender after acceptance of tender: -

The tenderers, whose tender is approved for acceptance, shall within 7 (seven) days of thereceipt of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) to him, will have to execute 'Formal Agreement' with the Tender Accepting Authority in six copies and one original copy of KMDA Form No. I which may be purchased on Demand Draft from the office of the Executive Engineer concerned with the work.

7.3 The NIT shall form a part of the contract agreement. On acceptance of the bid, the successfulbidder shall have to sign consisting of NIT, instruction to bidders, special terms and conditions, specification, BOQ, Drawing, Rate quoted, LOAandTenderForm No. - I.

7.4 Return of Earnest Money of the unsuccessful Tenderer(s)

For return of the Earnest Money of the unsuccessful tender(s), he/she/they is/are to apply for the same to the Tender Inviting Authority, giving the reference to the work, NIT No, date of tenderamount and mode of Earnest Money deposited – all in a complete form. The Earnest Money of all tenderers other than the lowest tenderers in each case may be refunded without any interest to the unsuccessful tender(s), after award of contract to the Successful Tenderer. The E.M.D of successful Tenderer will be converted as Retention money and shall be released after securityperiod as mentioned in section C.

8. Payment

The payment of RA as well as final bill for any work will be made according to the availability of fundand no claim to delay in payment will be entertained.

9. Security Deposit

- Earnest Money @ 2% of the estimated value put to tender would be converted to SecurityDepositincaseofthesuccessfulbidder.SecurityDeposittowardsperformancesecurityamoun ting to @8.0% of the work value shall be deducted from the R/A Bill, so the total SecurityDepositremainas10%ofthewholeworkvalueasperprevailingorder.Nointerestwillbepaidon SecurityDeposit.However,theorderofFinance Dept/Govtof W.B. relevant at the time deduction of Security Deposit from the R/A bill, shall be followed inthis regard.
- ii) After completion of the work, the Contractor may opt for refund of the Security Deposit byreplacing equal amount of Bank Guarantee of scheduled Bank valid upto the end of the defectliability period.

4.4 Opening and evaluation of Financial Proposal
