3.3 Siteinspectionbeforesubmissionoftender

3.5 **Conditional and incomplete tender**

Conditional and incomplete tenders are liable to summary rejection.

4. Openingandevaluationoftender

4.1 OpeningofTechnicalProposal

4.4 OpeningandevaluationofFinancialProposal
