## 3. CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY OF BIDDERS:

Bidders must read carefully the minimum conditions of eligibility (the "Conditions of Eligibility") provided here in. Proposals of only those Bidders who satisfy the Conditions of Eligibility will be considered for further evaluation/technical scoring.

To be eligible for evaluation of its Proposal, the Bidder shall fulfill the following:

#### TECHNICAL CAPACITY:

- (i) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of a similar nature, as mentioned above in Sl. No. 1,of completed work in single tender for preparation of Detailed Design, Drawing of Building works of minimum total built-up area of 1,50,000 Sq ft. during last 05 (five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice; or
- (ii) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of 2 (two) nos similar nature, as mentioned above in Sl. No. 1, of completed works for preparation of Detailed Design, Drawing of Building works of each having minimum total built-up area of 1,00,000 Sqft during last 05 (five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice.

The technical experience mentioned herein is the minimum eligibility criteria for completed projects for any Bidder. Over and above the Bidder may submit additional completed/submitted projects for claiming the Technical Capacity in accordance with respective clause of the NIQ document. However, ongoing projects will be considered for evaluation only if the Bidder has received atleast 80% of the professional fees /assignment value or completed atleast 80% of the assigned consultancy work for the project and whose completed total built up area is not less than 1,50,000 Sq ft.

The Bidder shall have received a minimum average revenue of Rs. 30Lakh per annum during last 03(three) financial years ending on 31.03.2023, For the avoidance of doubt, professional fees herein refers to fees received by the Bidder for providing advisory or consultancy services (excluding Audit, Accounting, Taxation and Information technology) to its clients for project development services/ preparation of Detailed Project Reports(DPRs), Technical Feasibility Studies, Project Management Consultancy services, Third Party/Independent Engineer/Owners Engineer Services, Technical Audit services, Assessment of existing assets etc. for Housing Projects.

#### 4. AVAILABILITY OF KEY PERSONNEL:

The Bidder shall offer and make available all Key Personnel meeting the requirements specified in the NIQ. The Bidder shall enclose with its Proposal, certificate(s) regarding qualification and experience of the Key Personnel.

## 5. EARNEST MONEY:-

The Earnest Money shall be Rs.1,50,000/-(Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only), deposited through online as per the system in the tender portal i.e (www.wbtenders.gov.in) in the respective field, failing which the tender shallbe rejected.

## 6. SPECIAL SECURITY DEPOSIT (PERFORMANCE SECURITY DEPOSIT):-

The selected bidder shall have to deposit an amount @ 5% of the amount quoted as Special Security Deposit as a guarantee for efficient completion of the project. Online EMD will be converted to Special Security Deposit and the balance amount to match the 5% of the quoted amount shall be submitted in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "KMDA" of a scheduled Indian Bank on Kolkata, if Special Security Deposit amount exceeds already deposited EMD. The Special Security Deposit shall have to be submitted within 15 days of receiving of the Letter of Intent (LOI). KMDA will not pay any interest on Security Deposit and Special Security Deposit. The Special Security Deposit shall be released after successful completion of construction work.

#### 7. TIME OF COMPLETION:

Time of completion shall be 60(Sixty) days for submission of all documents including DPR as mentioned in TOR of RFP for further process for approval of scheme and execution activities in soft and hard copy and shall be reckoned from the date of issuance of work order.

Language of Tender/Quotation/EOI cum RFP Proposal: -

The tender shall be submitted in the prescribed form in *English*. All literatures and correspondence in connection with the tenders shall be in English.

#### 8. BID OPENING: -

Bids received shall be opened online at the specified date and time given in NIQ/Proposal. If the office is closed on the specified date of opening of the bids, the opening shall be done on the next working day at the same time.

## 9. CONDITION FOR EVALUATION ON ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 11. - 12. Scanned Copy of one affidavit before Notary will have to be submitted mentioning the correctness of the documents and a declaration of penalty debarment etc. faced by him under any Govt./Semi-Govt./ Govt. Undertaking/ Autonomous body (constituted under the State/Central statute)/ Statutory Bodies and Local Bodies, submitted through online at desired location as per Annexure-I and declaration by the tenderer as per prescribed format (Annexure-II). Also, scanned copy of affidavit before Notary will have to be uploaded mentioning the correctness of CV of key personnel and experience claimed as per Annexure-III.
- 13. Validity of Tender: Tender once submitted shall remain valid for a period 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the date of opening of Financial Bid / Sealed Bid receiving tender. Any extension of such validity period will be subjected to the concurrence of the tenderer. If the bidder withdraws the bid during the period of bid validity the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.
- 14. No mobilization advance and secured advance will be allowed
- 15. The Bidder should submit a Power of Attorney as per the standard format.
- 16. The partnership firm shall furnish the registered partnership deed and the company shall furnish the Article of Association and Memorandum.
- 17. There shall be no provision of Arbitration. However, all the disputes, if any, arising from the provisions of the agreement come under the jurisdiction of Hon'ble Calcutta High Court.
- 18. No Adjustment of Price OR Price Escalation OR change in quoted rate of any kind will be allowed.

- 19. The Superintending Engineer, Circle-III, Housing Sector, KMDA reserves the right to cancel the N.I.Q/Proposal due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained. At any stage of bidding or even after award of contract if any inadvertent typographical mistake is found in the BOQ or any other tender document, the same will be so corrected as to conform to the prevailing relevant Schedule of Rate and/ or Technically Sanctioned Estimate or any other document as the case may be.
- 20. **CONDITIONAL and INCOMPLETE TENDER** will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 21. During scrutiny, if it is come to the notice to tender inviting authority that the credential or any other papers found incorrect/manufactured/fabricated, that tenderer will not be allowed to participate in the tender and that application will be out rightly rejected without any prejudice with forfeiture of earnest money forthwith.

Before issuance of the LOI, the tender inviting authority may verify the credential & other documents of the lowest tenderer if found necessary. After verification, if it is found that such documents submitted by the lowest tenderer is either manufacture or false in that case, LOI will not be issued in favour of the tenderer under any circumstances.

The bidder may be debarred from participating any tender further in KMDA at any stage on the following grounds-

#### A) GROUNDS FOR DEBARMENT

- i) Submission of eligibility requirements containing false information or falsified documents.
- ii) Submission of Bids that contain false information or falsified documents, or the concealment of such information in the Bids in order to influence the outcome of eligibility screening or any other stage of the bidding process.
- iii) Unauthorized use of one's name/digital signature certificate for purpose of bidding process.
- iv) Any documented unsolicited attempt by a bidder to unduly influence the outcome of the bidding in his favour.
- v) Refusal or failure to post a self-declaration to the effect of any previous debarment imposed by any authority of State / Central Govt., State / Central Govt. Undertaking / Statutory Bodies constituted under the statute of the Central/State Govt.
- vi) All other acts that tend to defeat the purpose of the competitive bidding such as lodging false complain about any bidder, lodging false complain about any officer duly authorized by the department, restraining any interested bidder to participate in the bidding process, etc.
- vii) Assignment and subcontracting of the contract or any part thereof without prior written approval of the procuring entity.
- viii) Whenever adverse reports related to adverse performance, misbehaviour, direct or indirect involvement in threatening, making false complaints etc. damaging the reputation of the department or any other type complaint considered fit by the competent authority of the department, are received from more than one officer or at more than one occasion from individual officer.
- ix) Refusal or failure to post the required performance security / earnest money within the prescribed time without justifiable cause.
- x) Failure in deployment of technical personnel, engineers and / or work supervisor having requisite license/ supervisor certificate of competency as specified in the Contract.
- xi) Refusal to accept an award after issuance of Letter of Intent or enter into contract with the authority without justifiable cause.
- xii) Failure of the contractor, due solely to his fault or negligence, to mobilize and start worker

performance within the specified period as mentioned in the Letter of Intent, Letter of Intent cum Work Order, Work Order etc.

- xiii) Failure by the contractor to fully and faithfully comply with its contractual, obligations without valid cause, or failure by the contractor to comply with any written lawful instruction of the procuring entity or its representative(s) pursuant to the implementation of the contract.
- xiv) For the procurement of consultancy service/ contracts, poor performance by the consultant of his services arising from his fault or negligence. Any of the following acts by the consultant shall be construed as poor performance.
  - a) Non deployment of competent technical personnel, competent engineers and / or work supervisors;
  - b) Non deployment of committed equipment, facilities, support staff and manpower; and
  - c) Defective design resulting in substantial corrective works in design and/or construction;
  - d) Failure to deliver critical outputs due to consultants fault or negligence; and
  - e) Specifying materials which are inappropriate and substandard or way above acceptable standards leading to high procurement cost.
  - f) Allowing defective workmanship or works by the contractor being supervised by the consultant.
- xv) For the procurement of goods, unsatisfactory progress in the delivery of the goods by the manufacturer, supplier or distributor arising from his fault or negligence and/or unsatisfactory or inferior quality of goods, vis a vis as laid down in the contract.
- xvi) Willful or deliberate abandonment or non-performance of the project or contract by the contractor resulting to substantial breach thereof without lawful and/or just cause.

## B) CATEGORY OF VIOLATION/MISCONDUCT:-

- i) First degree of violation/misconduct:- Cl. No. 37.A (i) to 37.A (xvi) to be considered as first degree of violation/misconduct.
- ii) Second degree of violation/misconduct:- Any one of the acts as mentioned under Cl. 37.B (i) above, committed by a particular bidder/contractor/supplier by more than one occasions, be considered as second degree of violation/misconduct.

In addition to the penalty of debarment, the bid security / earnest money posted by the concerned bidder or prospective bidder shall also be forfeited.

(The same must be invariably part of the process of evaluation of bids.)

## C) PENALTY:-

- i) For committing 1st Degree of violation/misconduct:- Disqualifying a bidder from participating in any tender process under KMDA up to 2(two) years.
- ii) For committing 2nd Degree of violation/misconduct:- Disqualifying a bidder from participating in any tender process under KMDA for a period of 3(three) years.

List of "Technically Qualified Bidders" will be published in the web portal only. Financial Bid will be opened within a short period after such publication. Therefore, Bidders are requested to view the tender status on a regular basis. In case if there be any objection regarding Pre-qualification/ list of "Technically Qualified Bidders", that objection should be lodged to the Tender/Bid Evaluation Committee within 48 hours from the date and time of publication of list of qualified Agencies and beyond that time schedule no objection will be entertained by the Tender/Bid Evaluation Committee.

## 22. Payment: -

The payment of RA as well as final bill for any work will be made according to the availability of fund and no claim to delay in payment will be entertained.

- 23. No Bidder or its Associate shall submit more than one Proposal for the Consultancy.
- 24. Any entity which has been barred by the Central Government, any State Government, a statutory authority or a public sector undertaking, as the case may be, from participating in any project, and the bar subsists as on the date of Proposal, would not be eligible to submit a Proposal either by itself or through its Associate. The bid will be summarily rejected, EMD will be forfeited and

suitable action will be exercised if the bidders hide the bar imposed, if any.

- 25. Bidder should have, during the last three years, neither failed to perform on any agreement, as evidenced by imposition of a penalty by an arbitrator or judicial authority or a judicial pronouncement or arbitration award against the Bidder or its Associate, nor been expelled from any project or agreement nor have had any agreement terminated for any breach by such Bidder or its Associate.
- 26. The Bidders shall be responsible for all of the costs associated with the preparation of their Proposals and their participation in the Selection Process including subsequent negotiation, visits to the KMDA, Project site etc. The KMDA will not be responsible or in any way liable for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Selection Process.
- 27. Bidders are encouraged to submit their respective Proposals after visiting the Project site and ascertaining for themselves the site conditions, traffic, location, surroundings, climate, access to the site, availability of drawings and other data with the KMDA, Applicable Laws and regulations or any other matter considered relevant by them. Visits shall be organized for the benefit of prospective Bidders on dates, time and venue.

## 28. RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL PROPOSALS:

Notwithstanding anything contained in this RFP, the KMDA reserves the right to accept or reject any Proposal and to annul the Selection Process and reject all Proposals, at any time without any liability or any obligation for such acceptance, rejection or annulment, and without assigning any reasons thereof. Without prejudice to the generality, the KMDA reserves the right to reject any Proposal if:

i. At any time, a material misrepresentations made or discovered, or

ii. The Bidder does not provide, within the time specified by the KMDA, the supplemental information sought by the KMDA for evaluation of the Proposal.

Misrepresentation/ improper response by the Bidder may lead to the disqualification of the Bidder. If such disqualification / rejection occurs after the Proposals have been opened and the highest ranking Bidder gets disqualified / rejected, then the KMDA reserves the right to consider the next best Bidder, or take any other measure as may be deemed fit in the sole discretion of the KMDA, including annulment of the Selection Process.

## 29. AMENDMENT OF PROPOSAL:

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Proposal, the KMDA may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to clarifications requested by a Bidder, modify the RFP document by the issuance of Addendum / Amendment / Corrigendum and posting it on the Official Website.

In order to afford the Bidders a reasonable time for taking an amendment into account, or for any other reason, the KMDA may, in its sole discretion, extend the Proposal Due Date.

## 30. Others :-

The Tender Notice along with other documents likes KMDA Tender Form No. – 1, Special Terms and Conditions, BOQ, Addendums and corrigendum etc. whatever documents uploaded by the department concerned thereto shall be part and parcel of the Tender. The agency must go through carefully the Special Terms and Conditions uploaded by the department before quoting his rate. All the bidders are requested to upload only necessary documents for the tender. Uploading unnecessary/irrelevant documents may create problem in the evaluation process. In that case if any inadvertent mistake happens during evaluation of the tender, Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) will not be responsible.

#### 31. Penalty for suppression/distortion of facts:

If any document/statement/information submitted by any bidder in the tender is found to be false, the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) will take legal action against the bidder including forfeiture of Earnest Money Deposited (EMD)."

The tender inviting authority (TIA) reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.

32. The Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC) for the evaluation and further related

all processing of bids/tenders submitted comprises of (i) Superintending Engineer as Chairperson, (ii) concerned Executive Engineer as member, (iii) Estimator to Superintending Engineer as member and (iv) Divisional Accountant as member. The tender inviting authority (TIA) on recommendation of BEC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.

While evaluation, the committee may summon of the tenderers & seek clarification/information or additional documents or original in hardcopy/softcopy, if any shortfall documents may required by the TIA it shall only be uploaded in Tender portal (www.wbtenders.gov.in) within the stipulated time period.

Any of the documents already submitted/seeking by TIA during Bid evaluation, if they are not produced within the stipulated time frame, their bid will liable for rejection.

## A. EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL PROPOSALS:-

- i) In the first stage, the Technical Proposal will be evaluated on the basis of Bidder's working experience as credential, Qualification and the experience of the Key Personnel & financial capabilities as per table mentioned above. Only those Bidders whose Technical Proposals get a score of 60 (Sixty) marks or more out of 100 (One Hundred) shall qualify for further consideration.
- ii) Each Key Personnel must score a minimum of 60% (sixty per cent) marks except as provided herein.
- Bidders ranked as per Technical Score (S<sub>T</sub>) achieved as aforesaid, shall be short-listed for financial evaluation in the second stage. However, if the number of such Bidders is less than three, the KMDA may, in its sole discretion, shortlist the Bidder whose technical score is less than 60 (Sixty) marks even if such Bidder does not qualify in terms of Clause A.ii; provided that in such an event, the total number of short-listed Bidders shall not exceed three

- i) In the second stage, the financial evaluation will be carried out as per this Clause. Each Financial Proposal will be assigned a financial score ( $S_F$ ).
- ii) For financial evaluation, the total cost quoted through online, shall be considered as Financial Proposal of the work including all taxes & Cess, Manpower Costs and all other additional Costs etc.
- The KMDA will determine whether the Financial Proposals are complete, unqualified and unconditional. The cost indicated in the Financial Proposal shall be deemed as final and reflecting the total cost of services. Omissions, if any, in costing any item shall not entitle the firm to be compensated and the liability to fulfill its obligations as per the proposal within the total quoted price shall be that of the Consultant. The lowest Financial Proposal (F<sub>L</sub>) will be given a financial score (S<sub>F</sub>) of 100 points. The financial scores of other Proposals will be computed as follows:

 $S_F = 100 \text{ x } F_L/F$  (F = amount of Financial Proposal)

# C. COMBINED QUALITY CUM COST BASED SYSTEM AND FINAL EVALUATION carried out on 70:30:-

i) Proposals will finally be ranked according to their combined technical (S<sub>τ</sub>) and financial (S<sub>τ</sub>) scores as follows:

$$S = (S_T x T_w + S_F x F_w)$$

Where **S** is the combined score, and  $T_w$  and  $F_w$  are weightage assigned to Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal, which shall be 0.70 and 0.30 respectively i.e 70% & 30% ratio on Technical Score and financial Score.

ii) The Selected Bidder shall be the first ranked Bidder (having the highest combined score). The second ranked Bidder shall be kept in reserve and may be invited for negotiations subjected to approval of the authority in case the first ranked Bidder withdraws, or fails to comply with the specified requirements.

#### INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

Instruction/Guidelines for electronic submission of tenders online have been annexed for assisting the contractors to participate in e-tendering.

- 1. **Registration of Consultant:** Any contractor willing to take part in the process of e —Tendering will have to be enrolled & registered with the Government e Procurement system through logging on to http://wbtenders.gov.in. The contractor is to click on the link for e—Tendering site as given on the web portal.
- 2. Digital Signature Certificate (DSC):- Each contractor is required to obtain a class II or class III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for submission of tenders from the approved service provider of the National Informatics Centre (NIC) on payment of requisite amount details are available at the Website stated in Guide line to Bidder. DSC is given as a USB e-Token.

Statutory Cover(folder) would be opened first & if found in order and correct Non Statutory Cover (folder) will be opened. If there is any deficiency in the Statutory & Non-statutory documents the tender will summarily be rejected.
- ii) Decrypted (transformed in to readable formats) documents of the non-statutory cover will be downloaded & handed over to the evaluation committee.
- iii) List of technically qualified tenderers would be uploaded.
  - 6. A) During uploading of documents all bidders should be careful enough to assign the name of the file so that it can be easily understand about its content. Misleading file name may produce error in evaluation process for which Tender inviting Authority will not be responsible.
    - B) All the bidders are requested to upload only necessary documents for
