EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, CRS DIVISION** for and on behalf of Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority (KMDA) invites **e-QUOTATION** in KMDA Form No: 1 from reliable, resourceful, bonafide, and experienced eligible firms /companies/individual agencies having credentials of similar nature of work as detailed in Eligibility criteria for the under mentioned works:-

Time will be reckoned as per Server Clock. b) The Financial Bid of the participant Tenderers will be opened only if the Tenderer qualifies in the Technical Bid evaluation.
4. Intending bidder should quote the rate including all Government, Statutory taxes including GST and Labour Cess as applicable. The Tax invoice(s) need to be issued by the agency/supplier for raising claim under the contract showing separately, the tax charged in accordance with the provisions of GST Act, 2017.

Quotation will be opened by the Executive Engineer, CRS Division, E&AM SECTOR, KMDA or his authorized representative in presence of Quotationer or their authorized representatives who may like to be present.

6. Eligibility criteria for the bidders :-

- i) The prospective bidders shall have satisfactorily completed as a prime agency during the last 5(five) years prior to the date of issue of this Notice at least one work of similar nature as mentioned above in Sl No-1.under the authority of State/Central Gov., State/Central Gov. undertaking /Statutory Bodies constituted under the statute of the Central / State Government and having a magnitude of at least **40%** of the Estimated amount put to tender, or
- ii) Intending Quotationers/bidders should produce credentials of 2(two) nos of similar nature of completed works as mentioned above in Sl No-1, each of the minimum value of **30%** of the estimated amount put to tender during 5(five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice, **or**
- iii) Intending Quotationers / bidders should produce credentials of one single running work of similar nature as mentioned above in Sl No-1 which has been completed to the extent of **80%** or more and value of executed part of which is not less than the desired value at (i) above.

In case of running works, the Quotationers /bidders shall submit the present performance certificate of satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer, or equivalent competent authority and in that required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work is in progress satisfactorily and also that no penal action has been initiated against the executing agency, i.e. the Quotationers /bidders.

- A) Scanned copy of PAN card, P. Tax clearance challan,Valid Income tax(For last 3yrs), GST audited balance sheet, Credentials, Work Order, Payment certificate and other supporting documents, Registration Certificate and/or trade license of the company must be submitted duly digitally signed at desired location in the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in>.
- B) Scanned Copy of one affidavit before Notary will have to be submitted mentioning the correctness of the documents and a declaration of penalty debarment etc. faced by him under any Govt./Semi-Govt./Autonomous body/Institution through on line at desired location.
- C) Bank Solvency Certificate, minimum value @ 10% (Ten Percent) of quoted amount or above and date of which shall not be more than 6 (six) months before the publication date of the e-NIQ.

7. **Earnest Money:-** The original document of EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) should be furnished before the Quotation Inviting Authority, when asked to do so during evaluation of the Tenders.

8. a) List of common documents shall have to be uploaded by each Tenderer at the time of submission of Quotation through online:-

- i. Income Tax e-Return (For last 3yrs)
- ii. Audited Balance sheet(For last 3yrs)
- iii. Pan Card.
- iv. Trade License
- v. Latest Professional Tax Paid Challan & P-TAX Enrollment Certificate and P. Tax Payment Certificate
- vi. GST registration certificate and Latest GST Return form 3B
- vii. Valid Renewed Trade License.
- viii. Work Order along with completion certificate.
- ix. Valid Employees Provident Fund and ESI registration certificates with latest/ up-to-date paid challan upto March., 2026
- x. Bank solvency according to serial 5.D of eligibility criteria.
- xi. Affidavit before Notary mentioning the NIT No. as well as the correctness of the documents and declaration of penalty, debarment etc.

b) List of documents shall have to upload by a Partnership Firm in addition to Cl. No.8.a)

- i)The power of Attorney for the firm for signing the tender by a partner.
- ii)Registered Partnership Deed.

Note : Bidder should comply the minimum wages as per Financial Norms.

9. ADDITIONAL PERFORMANCE SECURITY IN PROJECT:

The Additional Performance Security @10% of the tendered amount shall be obtained from successful bidder, if the accepted bid value is 80% or less of the estimate put to tender as per Memo No-4608-F(Y) dated 18/07/2018 of Finance Deptt. Additional Performance Security shall be equal to 10% of the tendered amount and be submitted at the concerned Division office in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Scheduled Bank before issuance of the Work Order and it should be uploaded in BRGF Portal as per rules there. If the bidder fails to submit the Additional Performance Security within seven working days from the date of issuance of Letter of Acceptance, his earnest money will be forfeited and other necessary action as per NIT like Blacklisting of the contractor etc. may be taken. The said Bank Guarantee shall have to be valid up to the end of the Successful completion of the work and shall be renewed accordingly, if required. The said Bank Guarantee shall be returned immediately after successful completion of the work. If the bidder fails to complete the work successfully, the Additional Performance Security shall be forfeited at any time during the pendency of the Contract period after serving proper notice to the contractor.

Necessary provisions regarding deduction of security deposit from the progressive bills of the contractor as per relevant clauses of the contract will in no way affected / altered by this Additional Performance Guarantee.

11. Language of Tender:- The Tender shall be submitted in the prescribed form in English. All literatures and correspondence in connection with the Tenders shall be in English.

12. Others :- The Tender Notice along with other documents like Tender Form No. -1 KMDA, Technical Specification, Special Terms and Conditions , BOQ, Addendum and corrigendum etc. whatever documents uploaded by the department concerned thereto shall be part and parcel of the Tender.

13. Declaration:- Bidders must upload and submit duly digitally signed a declaration as per prescribed format for confirmation of his awareness of the contract.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

Instruction / Guidelines for Tenderers for electronic submission of Quotationer online have been annexed for assisting the contractors to participate in e- Tendering.

- 1. Registration of Contractor:** - Any contractor willing to take part in the process of e – Tendering will have to be enrolled & registered with the Government e – Procurement system through logging on to **<https://wbtenders.gov.in>**. The contractor is to click on the link for e – Tendering site as given on the web portal.
- 2. Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) :-** Each contractor is required to obtain a class - II or class – III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for submission of Tenders from the approved service provider of the national Information's Centre (NIC) on payment of requisite amount details are available at the Web Site stated in Clause -1 of Guideline to Bidder. DSC is given as a USB e – Token.
- 3. Collection of Tender documents:** - The contractor can search & download NIT & Tender documents electronically from computer once he logs on to the website mentioned Clause 1 using the Digital Signature Certificate. This is the only mode of collection of Tender documents.
- 4. Submission of Tenders :-**
 - a) General process of submission:-** Tenders are to be submitted through online to the website stated in Cl.1 in two folders at a time for each work, one is Technical bid and other is Financial Bid before the prescribed date and time using the Digital Signature Certificates.
 - b) Technical Bid:-** Technical Bid contain scanned copies of the followings further in two cover (folder).

A-1. Statutory Cover Containing.

- i) Earnest money (EMD) as prescribed in the NIT.
- ii) NIT.
- iii) Duly filled up Declaration as per prescribed format with manual Sign & Stamp.

N.B: Bidder must download KMDA Tender Form No-1, General Terms and Condition, Special Terms & Conditions, Technical Specifications, all other addendum, Corrigendum etc. whatever documents uploaded by the department in the website under the NIT and must go through carefully before quoting his rate. These documents are not necessarily be uploaded by the bidder.

A-2. Non Statutory/Technical documents Cover containing.

- i. Income Tax e-Return (For last 3yrs)
- ii. Balance sheet(For last 3yrs)
- iii. Pan Card.
- iv. Trade License
- v. Professional Tax Enrolment certificate with current year challan.

- ix. EPF & ESI Registration Certificate.

Note: Failure in submission of any of the above mentioned documents (as stated in A-1 & A-2) will render the Tender liable to be summarily rejected for both statutory & non statutory cover.

Click the check boxes beside the necessary documents in the My Document list and then click the tab "Submit Non Statutory Documents" to send the selected documents to Non Statutory folder. Next Click the tab "Click to Encrypt and upload" and then click the "Technical" Folder to upload the Technical Documents.

Financial Bid:-

- i) The financial bid should contain the following documents in one cover (folder) i.e. Bill of Quantities (BOQ). The contractor is to quote the rate through on line in the space marked for quoting rate in the BOQ.
- ii) Only downloaded copies of the above documents are to be uploaded, virus scanned & digitally Signed by the contractor.
- iii) **The quoted rate should be including GST & L.Cess.**

6. Opening & Evaluation of Tender:-

Opening of Technical Bid:

- i) Technical bid will be opened by the Executive Engineer, CRS Division, E&AM SECTOR, KMDA Intending Tenderer may remain present if they so desire. Statutory Cover (folder) would be opened first & if found in order and correct Non Statutory Cover (folder) will be opened. If there is any deficiency in the Statutory & Non statutory documents the Tender will summarily be rejected.
- ii) Decrypted (transformed in to readable formats) documents of the non- statutory cover will be downloaded for evaluation.
- iii) List of technically qualified Tenderers would be uploaded.

During evaluation, the Tender Inviting Authority may summon of the Tenderers & seek clarification/ information or additional documents or original hard copy of any of the documents already submitted & if they are not produced within the stipulated time frame, their bid will liable for rejection.

Opening and evaluation of Financial Bid:

- i) Financial bid of Tenderers declared technically eligible by the Tender Evaluation Committee will be opened electronically from the web portal on the prescribed date and time.

7. Penalty for suppression / distortion of facts:

Submission of false document by Tenderer is punishable as per prevailing laws.

8. Tender inviting authority reserves the right for rejection & cancellation of the NIT at any time without showing any reason.
