



The Superintending Engineer, North Circle, GAP Wing, W & S Sector, KMDA invites online tender under “Namami Gange Programme” from experienced firms / companies / individual contractors / Joint Ventures / Consortium, who have successfully completed the work of similar nature of works within last 7 (seven) years from the date of this NIT in any Govt. / Semi-Govt. / Govt. Undertakings / Autonomous Bodies (constituted under the State / Central statute) / Statutory Bodies and Local Bodies is eligible for the under mentioned work.

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**Note: (i) Rate to be quoted including all applicable Govt. statutory duties and CESS but excluding GST. GST amount is to be calculated from the BOQ sheet.**

**Rate to be quoted excluding energy cost for O&M period (energy cost shall be paid by the Contractor to the relevant utility and same will be reimbursed as on actual basis subject to ceiling of Guaranteed energy consumption).**

**(1) Scope of Work:**

**The prospective Bidders are advised to refer to the bidding documents for complete details.**

**(2) Qualification requirements as listed briefly below are required to be fulfilled by the prospective Tenderers / Bidders.**

(3) **Financial:**

- A. The Bidder shall demonstrate that it possesses a net worth equivalent to minimum of **INR 21.63 Lakhs** in any each of the three financial years from last four years preceding the date of submission of bid.
- B. The Bidder shall demonstrate by submitting along with its bid, a banker's certificate that it has available cash credit facility equivalent to minimum **INR 17.30 Lakhs** as on the date of submission from any scheduled Bank or Public Finance Institute (PFI) and same has to be provided along with the technical bid.
- C. The Bidder's audited balance sheets or, if not required by the laws of country, other financial statements acceptable to the owner, for the last five years shall be submitted and must demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's financial position and indicate its prospective long term profitability. If deemed necessary by the owner, the owner shall have the authority to make inquiries with the bidder/s bankers.

(4) **Technical:**

- A. The Bidder shall provide evidence that it has designed, developed, built, tested, and commissioned Or, Rejuvenated and commissioned -- STP / CETP / WTP or Similar Nature Work having a Chlorination unit, during the last 7 years preceding the month of publication of NIT as per the following criteria:
- a) One (01) STP/CETP/WTP or Similar Nature Work of 8 MLD capacity. OR
- b) Two (02) STP/CETP/WTP or Similar Nature Work of 6.00 MLD capacity each. OR
- c) Three (03) STP/CETP/WTP or Similar Nature Work of 4.00 MLD capacity each.
- B. The Bidder or his nominated sub-contractor has the experience in operating and maintaining successfully one STP / CETP /WTP with Chlorination Unit, based on the minimum capacity as mentioned above in Clause 4(A) for at least 1 year over the last 7 years preceding the month on publication of NIT.

- (5) Scanned copy of original document of Valid PAN issued by the IT Department, Govt. of India, Latest Professional Tax Paid Challan as per Enrollment Rate Slab & P. - (6) Scanned Copy of one affidavit before Notary will have to be submitted mentioning the correctness of the documents and a declaration of penalty debarment etc. faced by him under any Govt. / Semi-Govt. / Govt. Undertaking / Autonomous body (constituted under the State / Central statute) / Statutory Bodies and Local Bodies, submitted through online at desired location.
- (7) Proprietorship Firm /Partnership Firm /Consortium should submit necessary deed as per Annexure mentioned in the Bid Document at desired location through online.

- (10) Submission of Tender- a) Pre-qualification/Technical Bid and Financial Bid both will have to be submitted online concurrently duly digitally signed on the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in> as per time schedule stated herein under. Time will be reckoned as per Server Clock. b) The Financial Bid of the prospective Tenderers / Bidders will be opened only if the tenderer qualifies in the Technical Bid. The decision of the Tender Inviting Authority will be final and binding to all concerned and no challenge against such decision will be entertained.
- (11) Tenders will be opened by the Superintending Engineer, North Circle, GAP Wing, W & S Sector, KMDA or his authorized representative in presence of tenderer or their authorized representatives who may like to be present.
- (12) Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding and is open to all eligible bidders.

The prospective Tenderer / Bidder shall have to submit scan copy of Bid Security through online, failing which the tender shall be rejected.

- (15) During scrutiny, if it comes to the notice of the Tender inviting authority that the credential or any other paper found incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, that bidder would not be allowed to participate in the Tender and that application will be rejected without any prejudice.

**All the bidders are requested to upload only necessary documents for the tender. Uploading unnecessary / irrelevant documents may create problem in the evaluation process. In that case any inadvertent mistake during evaluation of the tender, Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) will not be responsible.**

- (16) List of “Technically Qualified Bidders” will be published in the web portal only. The Financial Bid of the prospective Tenderers will be opened only if the tenderer qualifies in the Technical Bid. In case if there be any objection regarding Pre-qualification/ list of “Technically Qualified Bidders”, that objection should be lodged to the Tender Inviting Authority within **48 hours (02 days)** from the date and time of publication of list of qualified Agency and beyond that time schedule no objection will be entertained by the Tender Inviting Authority. The decision of the Tender Inviting Authority will be final and binding to all concerned and no challenge against such decision will be entertained.
- (17) Conditional / Incomplete Tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- (18) Bidder shall submit the hard copy of the original Bid Security and other documents to the Tender Inviting Authority. Failure to submit the hard copy within the time period prescribed in the bid document may be construed as an attempt to disturb the tendering process and dealt with accordingly as per tender conditions.

L1 bidder shall give acceptance of letter of the LOI and submit the Performance Bank Guarantee later as directed. Failure to submit the acceptance letter and the performance Bank Guarantee within the time period prescribed for the purpose may be construed as an attempt to disturb the tendering process and dealt with accordingly as per tender conditions including blacklisting of the bidder.

If the successful bidder is a Joint Venture (JV) firm, the Performance Security and ESHS Performance Security may be furnished on behalf of the JV firm including names of all the participants in the joint venture prior to execution of the formal Agreement.

- (19) The following clause shall be included in all the contracts to be executed for (i) procurement of goods and services and (b) works related contract involving supply of goods and services by contractor: “Tax invoice(s) needs to be issued by the supplier for

raising claim under the contract showing separately the tax charged in accordance with the provisions of current GST Rules.”

(21) Neither prospective bidders nor any of constituent partner had been debarred to participate in tender by the KMDA during the last 5 (five) years prior to the date of this NIQ. Such debar will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect has to be furnished by the prospective bidders as per prescribed format without which the Technical Bid shall be treated non-responsive).

(22) **Bids shall remain valid** for a period not less than **180 days (One Hundred and Eighty)** from the last date of submission of Financial Bid / Sealed Bid. If the bidder withdraws the

bid during the period of bid validity the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.

- (23) **CONDITIONAL and INCOMPLETE TENDER** will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- (24) During scrutiny, if it is come to the notice to quotation inviting authority that the credential or any other papers found incorrect/manufactured/fabricated, that quotationer will not be allowed to participate in the quotation and that application will be out rightly rejected without any prejudice with forfeiture of earnest money forthwith.  
List of “Technically Qualified Bidders” will be published in the web portal only. Financial Bid will be opened within a short period after such publication. Therefore Bidders are requested to view the tender status on a regular basis. In case if there be any objection regarding Pre- qualification/ list of “ Technically Qualified Bidders”, that objection should be lodged to the Chairman, Quotation/Bid Evaluation Committee within **24 hours** from the date and time of publication of list of qualified Agency and beyond that time schedule no objection will be entertained by the Quotation/Bid Evaluation Committee.
- (25) During Technical evaluation, the tender inviting authority may verify the credential & other documents of the Bidder if found necessary. After verification, if it is found that such documents submitted by the Bidder is either manufacture or false in that case, Bidder’s Earnest Money/ Bid Security shall be forfeited.
- (26) **Language of Tender:-** The tender shall be submitted in the prescribed form in English. All literatures and correspondence in connection with the tenders shall be in English.
- (27) **Penalty for suppression / distortion of facts:** If any document / statement / information submitted by any participating bidder in the tender is found to be false at any stage of Tendering as well as in execution of the Work Process, the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) will take legal action against the participating bidder including forfeiture of Bid Security and/or Debarment of the Bidder for taking part in any kind of Tendering Procedure under KMDA or any other type of penalty measure as per **PWD Order No. 724-W(C)/1M-953/19, dated 19.12.2019 and Memorandum No. 547-W(C)/1M-387/15, dated 16.11.2015 and/or existing norms and/or Legal opinion whatsoever.**
- (28) **Blacklisting/ Poor Performance / Termination:** The bidder should not have been blacklisted or debarred during the five years preceding the date of issuance of the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) by any Central or State Government/Semi-government / PSUs / PHED / Water Boards / Water Utility departments. Such suspension / debarment, unless the same has been revoked, will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. The bidder should not have been terminated for their poor performance during the two years preceding the date of issuance of the NIT by any Central or State Government/Semi-government / PSUs / PHED / Water Boards / Water Utility departments. Such termination

of the bidder will result in disqualification from this tender, unless otherwise directed by competent legal authorities.

(29) **Insolvency / Bankruptcy Code:** The applicant should not be currently under any **Insolvency Bankruptcy Code (IBC)** resolution process at National Company Law Tribunal (NCTL).

(30) **The Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.**

(31) While evaluation, the committee may summon the tenderers & seek clarification/ information or additional documents or original in hard copy/soft copy, if any shortfall documents may require by the TIA it shall only be uploaded in Tender portal ([www.wbtenders.gov.in](http://www.wbtenders.gov.in)) within the stipulated time period.

*Any of the documents already submitted & if they are not produced within the stipulated time frame, their bid will liable for rejection.*

(33) If the L1 bidder does not agree to execute the job after opening of Bid, the Earnest Money will be forfeited without any further intimation and may be construed as an attempt to disturb the tendering process and dealt with accordingly legally including debarment up to 3(three) years of the Bidder.

(34) **Suspension and Debarment of Bidders, Contractors and Consultants during competitive bidding and contract implementation:**

The procedure as laid down below shall govern the suspension/debarment of Bidders/Contractors/Consultants (Contractors for brevity) involved in Government procurement for offences or violations committed during competitive bidding and contract implementation, for the works under different Departments of Government of West Bengal: - Grounds for Suspension and Debarment: -

(1) Submission of eligibility requirements containing false information or falsified documents.

(2) Submission of Bids that contain false information or falsified documents, or the concealment of such information in the Bids in order to influence the outcome of eligibility screening or any other stage of the bidding process.

(3) Unauthorized use of one's name/digital signature certificate for the purpose of bidding process.

(4) Any documented unsolicited attempt by a bidder (A Person/Contractor/Agency /Joint Venture/Consortium/Corporation participating in the procurement process and/or a person / Contractor / Agency / Joint Venture / Consortium / Corporation having an agreement/contract for any procurement with the department shall be referred as Bidder) unduly influencing the outcome of the bidding in his favour.

(5) Refusal or failure to post a self-declaration to the effect of any previous debarment imposed by any other department of State Government and/or Central Government.

- (6) All other acts that tend to defeat the purpose of the competitive bidding such as lodging false complain about any Bidder, lodging false complain about any Officer duly authorized by the Department, restraining any interested bidder to participate in the bidding process, etc.
- (7) Assignment and subcontracting of the contract or any part thereof without prior written approval of the procuring entity.
- (8) Whenever adverse reports related to adverse performance, misbehavior, direct or indirect involvement in threatening, making false complaints etc. damaging the reputation of the department or any other type complaint considered fit by the competent authority of the department, are received from more than one Officer or on more than one occasion from individual Officer.
- (9) Refusal or failure to post the required performance security / earnest money within the prescribed time without justifiable cause.
- (10) Refusal to accept an award after issuance of "Letter of Acceptance" or enter into contract with the Government without justifiable cause.
- (11) Failure of the Contractor, due solely to his fault or negligence, to mobilize and start work or performance within the specified period as mentioned in the "Letter of Acceptance", "Letter of Acceptance cum Work Order", "Work Order", "Notice to Proceed", "Award of Contract", etc.
- (12) Failure by the Contractor to fully and faithfully comply with its contractual obligations without valid cause, or failure by the Contractor to comply with any written lawful instruction of the Procuring Entity/Authority (the Officer authorized by the KMDA for procurement and execution) or its representative(s) pursuant to the implementation of the Contract.
- (13) For the procurement of Consultancy Service/Contracts, poor performance by the Consultant of his services arising from his fault or negligence. Any of the following acts by the Consultant shall be construed as poor performance. (i) Non-deployment of competent technical personnel, competent Engineers and/or work supervisors; (ii) Non-deployment of committed equipment, facilities, support staff and manpower; (iii) Defective design resulting in substantial corrective works in design and/or construction; (iv) Failure to deliver critical outputs due to consultant's fault or negligence; (v) Specifying materials which are inappropriate and substandard or way above acceptable standards leading to high procurement cost; (vi) Allowing defective workmanship or works by the Contractor being supervised by the Consultant.
- (14) For the procurement of goods, unsatisfactory progress in the delivery of the goods by the manufacturer, supplier, or distributor arising from his fault or negligence and/or unsatisfactory or inferior quality of goods, vis-à-vis as laid down in the contract.
- (15) Willful or deliberate abandonment or non-performance of the project or Contract by the Contractor resulting in substantial breach thereof without lawful and/or just cause.

**CATEGORY OF OFFENCE: -**

(A) First degree of offence: 1 to 15 of the above Article to be considered as First degree of offence.

(B) Second degree of offence: Any one of the offences as mentioned under 'A' above, committed by a particular Bidder/Contractor/Supplier on more than one occasion, be considered as Second degree of offence.

**In addition to the penalty of suspension/debarment, the bid security / earnest money posted by the concerned Bidder or prospective Bidder shall also be forfeited.**

**PENALTY FOR OFFENCE :-**

(I) For committing First degree of offence: Disqualifying a Bidder from participating in any procurement process under the Administrative Department of Government of West Bengal up to 2 (two) years.

For committing Second degree of offence: Disqualifying a Bidder from participating in any procurement process under the Administrative Department of Government of West Bengal up to 3 (three) years.


