1. Invitation:- Superintending Engineer, North Circle, GAP Wing, W & S Sector, KMDA invites online e-tender from reliable, resourceful, bonafied and experienced firms / companies / individual contractors / joint venture / consortium, Who have successfully Designed, Developed, Built, Tested, Commissioned with all Electromechanical components including minimum 01 (One) year Operation & Maintenance, at least 01 (One) no. STP within the last 05 (Five) years from the date of issue of this NIT.

Completed the above stated works, as per documentary evidence submitted, in any Govt./ Semi-Govt./Govt. Undertakings/Autonomous Bodies (constituted under the State/Central statute)/ Statutory Bodies and Local Bodies are eligible for the under mentioned works.

6. Eligibility criteria for the bidders :-

a) Technical:-

- i. Intending tenderers (firms / companies / individual contractors / joint venture / consortium) should have experience in the role of prime contractor (single entity or JV member) for Design, Construction, Testing & Commissioning of minimum **1 no. 0.60 MLD Capacity STP / CETP / ETP** including successful **Operation & Maintenance** for at least **1 continuous year** in single project in India during last 05(five) years from the date of issue of this tender notice;

- ii. Intending tenderers (firms / companies / individual contractors / joint venture / consortium) should have experience in the role of prime contractor (single entity or JV member) for Design, Construction, Testing & Commissioning of minimum **2 nos. 0.45 MLD Capacity STP / CETP / ETP** including successful **Operation & Maintenance** for **at least 1 continuous year** in India during last 05(five) years from the date of issue of this tender notice;

OR

- iii. Intending tenderers (firms / companies / individual contractors / joint venture / consortium) should have experience in the role of prime contractor (single entity or JV member) for Design, Construction, Testing & Commissioning of minimum **1 no. 0.60 MLD Capacity STP / CETP / ETP** including successful **Operation & Maintenance of same STP at least 10 months (80% of 1 year)** in India during last 05(five) years from the date of issue of this tender notice;

In case of running works, only those tenderers who will submit the certificate of satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer, or equivalent competent authority will be eligible for the tender. In the required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work is in progress satisfactorily and-also that no penal action has been initiated against the executing agency, i.e., the tenderer.

[Note for above Sl. No. (iii): (a) Credential provided should be for completed and commissioned work and (b) In case of joint venture / consortium firm the credential of running work shall not be applicable]

#### **Financial:-**

Intending tenderers (firms / companies / individual contractors / joint venture / consortium) should produce minimum average annual turnover of **INR 9.29 Crore** for last 3 (Three) Financial Years.

[In case of joint venture / consortium, they should jointly meet at least 100% of the qualifying amount asked for]

- b) Scanned copy of PAN card issued by the IT Deptt., Govt. of India, Latest Professional Tax Paid Challan as per Enrollment Rate Slab, Valid income tax return (for Last 3 yrs i.e. year ending 2022), Valid 15 digit Goods and Services Taxpayer Identification Number (GSTIN) under GST Act, 2017 & Latest Valid Trade License, Last 3 yrs audited balance sheet i.e. year ending 2022, Credentials (Work Order & Completion Certificate of the same work), Bank Solvency Certificate, minimum Rs. 2.32 Crore within 6 (six) months from the date of publishing of NIT, valid Provident Fund & ESI Registration Certificate Registration Certificate and/or trade license of the company must be submitted duly digitally signed at desired location in the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in>.

- c) The following clause shall be included in all the contracts to be executed for (i) procurement of goods and services and (b) works related contract involving supply of goods and services by contractor: "Tax invoice (s) needs to be issued by the supplier for raising claim under the contract showing separately the tax charged in accordance with the provisions of GST Act, 2017."

d) Scanned Copy of one affidavit before Notary will have to be submitted mentioning the correctness of the documents and a declaration of penalty debarment etc. faced by him under any Govt./Semi-Govt./Govt. Undertaking /Autonomous body (constituted under the State/Central statute)/ Statutory Bodies and Local Bodies, submitted through online at desired location ( as per Annexure-I) and declaration by the tenderer as per prescribed format ( Annexure-II).

e) Partnership / Joint Venture / Consortium Firm should submit necessary deed at desired location through on line.

f) **Earnest Money:-** The initial Earnest Money shall be of Rs.10,00,000/- ( Rupees Ten Lakh Only), shall be deposited through online as per the system in the tender portal i.e. (www.wbtenders.gov.in) in the respective field, failing which the tender shall be rejected. The successful tenderer shall have to submit balance amount against Earnest Money @ 2% of the awarded tender value, if that exceeds already deposited EMD the balance amount will be deposited in the form of Bank Guarantee drawn in favour of "Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority" of a scheduled Indian Bank at Kolkata.


d) **Joint Venture / Consortium :**

Particulars regarding Joint Ventures/Consortium.

- i. One of the partners of any Joint Venture/ Consortium has to be designated as Lead partner and the same will be mentioned in MOA/MOU.
  - ii. The Lead partner must hold minimum 51% equity capital of the company to be formed between them during the tenure of contract implementation.
  - iii. The lead partner must have credential and satisfactory completion of the same nature of works of qualifying capacity asked for present tender in a single contract under any Govt./Semi-Govt. organization/Autonomous body (constituted under the State/Central statute) as principal employer within last 7 (Seven) years.
  - iv. Each of other partners shall meet individually not less than 25% of the qualifying criteria for present tender in a single contract under any Govt./Semi-Govt. organization/Autonomous body (constituted under the State/Central statute) as principal employer within last 7 (Seven) years.
  - v. However the lead partner along with other partners/ partner should jointly meet at least 100% of the qualifying criteria asked for.
  - vi. The lead partner shall have to apply for tender on behalf of Joint Ventures/ Consortium along with MoA/MoU.
  - vii. In case of any litigation or in the event of any default arises during the execution/contract period of the agreement, the lead partner and JV partner/s will remain fully responsible.
  - viii. If the successful Joint Ventures/Consortium bidder will have to submit GST Registration, Pan Card, Trade License immediately after issuance of LOI.
8. **Time of completion:** Time of completion shall be 12(Twelve) months including 01(One) month Trial Run and 15 (Fifteen) years O & M, O & M shall be reckoned from the date of completion of the Trial Run of the project.
9. **Provision of Defect Liability Period & Refund of Security Deposit :**  
Prospective bidders shall have to execute the work in such a manner so that appropriate service level for the stipulated work is to be maintained during stipulated contractual period till actual date of completion and a Defect Liability Period for the work is **01 (One) year from the date of actual successful completion of the work.** If any defect/ damage is found during the period as mentioned above, the contractor shall make good the same at his own expense to the specification at par with instant project work, or in default, the Engineer-in-charge may cause the same to be made good by other agency and deduct the expense (for which the certificate of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final) from any sums that may be then, or at any time thereafter become due to contractor, or from his security deposit, or the proceeds of the sale thereof, or of sufficient portion thereof or from any pending dues for any contract with KMDA. On expiry of 3 (Three) years from the actual date of completion, the full or balance security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor.
10. **Additional Performance Security:-**  
The authenticated estimated amount put to tender is reserved with the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA). The Additional Performance Security @10% of the tendered amount shall be obtained from successful bidder, if the accepted bid value is 80% or less of the estimated work value which is reserved with TIA, Additional Performance Security shall be equal to 10% of the tendered amount and be submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Scheduled Bank before issuance of the Work Order. If the bidder fails to submit the Additional Performance Security within seven working days from the date of issuance of Letter of Acceptance, his earnest money will be forfeited and other necessary action as per NIT like Blacklisting of the contractor, etc. may be taken. The said Bank Guarantee shall have to be valid upto the end of the Successful completion of the work and shall be renewed accordingly, if required. If the bidder fails to complete the work successfully, the Additional Performance Security shall be forfeited at any time during the pendency of the Contract period after serving proper notice to the contractor.

11. **Language of Tender:-** The tender shall be submitted in the prescribed form in English. All literatures and correspondence in connection with the tenders shall be in English.
12. **Validity of Tender:** Tender once submitted shall remain valid for a period 120 (one hundred twenty) days from the date of receiving tender. Any extension of such validity period will be subjected to the concurrence of the tenderer.
13. **Others:** - The Tender Notice along with other documents like **Tender Form No. - 1 KMDA, Technical Specification, Special Terms and Conditions, BOQ, Addendums and corrigendum's etc.** whatever documents uploaded by the department concerned thereto shall be part and parcel of the Tender. The agency must go through carefully the Special Terms and Conditions uploaded by the department before quoting his rate. **All the bidders are requested to upload only necessary documents for the tender. Uploading unnecessary/irrelevant documents may create problem in the evaluation process. In that case any inadvertent mistake during evaluation of the tender, Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) will not be responsible.**
14. **Penalty for suppression / distortion of facts:** If any document/statement/information submitted by any bidder in the tender is found to be false, the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) will take legal action against the bidder including forfeiture of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).”
15. **Blacklisting:** The bidder should not be blacklisted or debarred in last 5 years from any Central or State Government/Semi-government / PSUs / PHED / Water Boards / Water Utility departments.
16. **Insolvency / Bankruptcy Code:** The applicant should not be currently under any Insolvency Bankruptcy Code (IBC) resolution process at National Company Law Tribunal (NCTI).
17. The tender inviting authority (TIA) reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason what so ever.
18. While evaluation, the committee may summon the tenderers & seek clarification/information or additional documents or original in hard copy/soft copy, if any shortfall documents may require by the TIA it shall only be uploaded in Tender portal ([www.wbtenders.gov.in](http://www.wbtenders.gov.in)) within the stipulated time period.
19. Any of the documents already submitted & if they are not produced within the stipulated time frame, their bid will liable for rejection.
